



Anti-Human Trafficking Awareness Annual Requirement

Purpose:

MPI is committed to the fight against human trafficking and raising awareness about this industry-critical issue. Educating our members and the wider community about human trafficking is crucial to eradicating this heinous crime. To reach a broader audience, each MPI Chapter is required to incorporate an Anti-Human Trafficking (AHT) awareness activity in their local community once per calendar year.

Requirements:

- Create an awareness initiative each calendar year at your Chapter.
- Chapters are not restricted to the initiatives that appear in the resources area of the MPI website: <https://www.mpi.org/tools/anti-human-trafficking>
- Chapters may not repeat an initiative that has been used in the past two years to fulfill the annual requirement.

Reporting:

- Record the AHT Awareness activity in the month it occurs on the Chapter Metrics Dashboard, Engagement Statistics tab in the “AHT Requirement” field.
 - Enter “1” if one activity was completed.
- Include a summary of the activity in the “Metric Dashboard Notes” field (e.g., “In August, flyers were placed on all attendee chairs.”).
