She feels that the chapter's success hinges on its ability to lead. "Having strong presidents and board members since day one has helped our chapter become one of the most successful," she said. When the events are successful and the leadership is enthusiastic, membership grows and members become volunteers.

Brian Griffith, president of MPIMP, has also been a member since the formation of the chapter.
