ELECTIONS ONE-HALF OVER

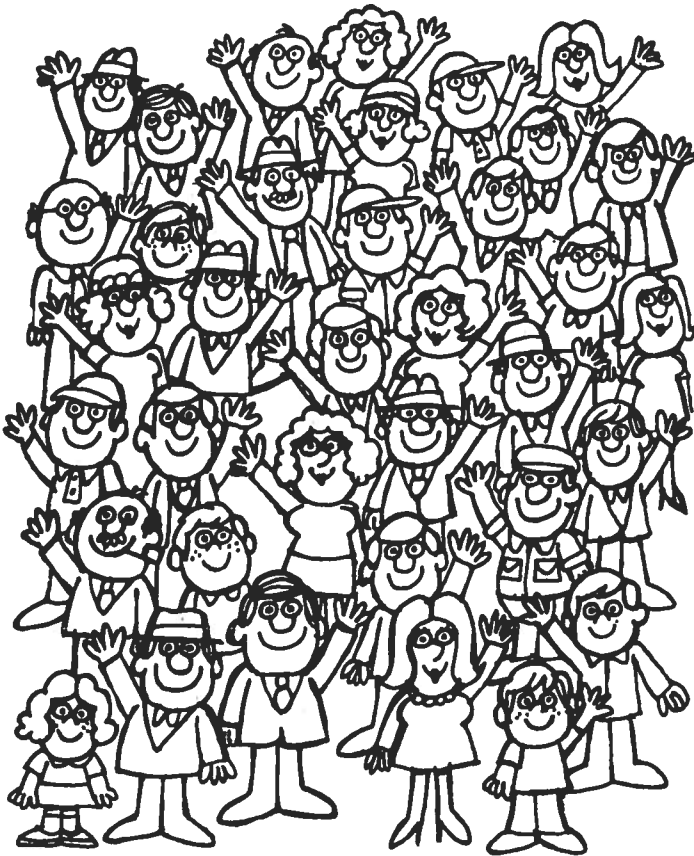

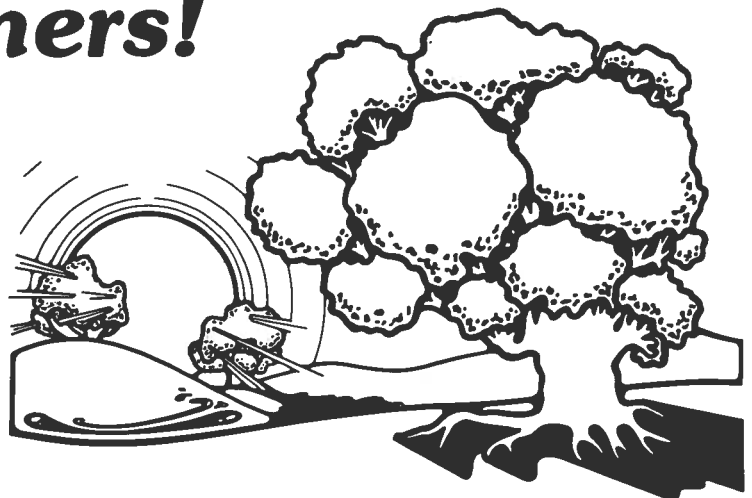
Coming....
