## Meeting Space & AV

- MPI KBC asks for complimentary meeting space to accommodate 50-75 at rounds for all educational programs and 75-100 for all Signature Event Series events at rounds.
- MPI KBC requests that essential audio-visual equipment be complimentary, whether your AV is in-house or provided by an external company.
- Complimentary equipment will include flipcharts, screens, wireless Lavalier microphones, lecterns, AV carts, LCD Projector, and Internet access.
- Décor and entertainment are at the venue's discretion and allow the venue's preferred vendors to showcase their work to meeting industry professionals and be listed as a supporting event sponsor.

## Food & Beverage

- Host venues to provide complimentary food and beverage. Inclusions will vary based on time of day, but sample needs are outlined below:
  - Brunch Event – plated or buffet brunch with beverages
  - Lunch Event – lunch buffet with beverages
  - Afternoon or Evening Event – snacks or hors d'oeuvres and cocktails
- If a venue is serving/offering cocktails, all persons servicing alcohol must be licensed bartenders. Venue hosts or catering vendors may serve complimentary wine or alcoholic beverages if they choose to enhance the food and beverage experience. Afternoon or evening events may include a cash or host bar.

## Guest Rooms

- For Educational events, we request a complimentary room to accommodate the speaker(s) when applicable. Note: Complimentary rooms are requested but not required to be selected as a host venue.

## Financial & Contractual Considerations

- MPI KBC is tax-exempt; a copy of our exemption certificate is provided upon request.
