Vision: To become the largest up cycler of sporting goods to underprivileged children in the world.

To date, GloBall Giving has shipped over 7 tons of goods to 19 countries and 11 major metropolitan areas. Currently, our shipments consist of 50% international and 50% domestic. Our goal for 2016 is to have positively effected 100,000 kids.
