



EMPI Award: Outstanding Planner Member

This award recognizes the contributions of an active planner member. The Meeting Planner creates new initiatives or acts as a catalyst for positive results. Nominees have demonstrated continued personal growth through mentoring, chapter leadership, and involvement in local service activities.

This award may be self-nominated or nominated by peers.

Criteria

Self-nominations are required to be validated by one (1) letter of recommendation by an individual or organization (the author does not need to be a MPI member). The letter should address the nominee's influence, innovation and transferability.

Influence	• Describe the nominee's overall contributions and commitment to the advancement of the meeting and events industry.
Innovation	• Describe any projects and programs that the nominee worked on to further enhance the industry.
Transferability	• Describe the nominee's impact beyond the meetings he/she plans.

Eligibility

- Nominee must be an individual (not organization) planner member of MPI in good standing.
- Nominee must have been a member of the MPI Minnesota Chapter for three (3) years or more.
- Nominee may not be a member of the judging panel.
