Multi-Chapter CMP Participant-Led Bootcamp

Welcome and thank you for joining today. This workshop will walk you through our upcoming Multi-Chapter CMP Bootcamp, designed to support meeting professionals preparing for the Certified Meeting Professional (CMP) exam.

What this bootcamp is:

- A structured, 9-week study program with weekly milestones to keep you accountable
- A participant-led learning experience where members take turns presenting CMP domains, supported by a facilitator
- A mix of live sessions + an on-demand resource library (recordings, slide decks, and shared materials)

Is This Bootcamp Right for You?

This program is designed for:

- CMP candidates planning to sit for the CMP exam
- Professionals who learn best through collaboration and discussion
- Individuals willing to actively participate and lead at least one session
- CMP candidates seeking structure, accountability, and peer support

Program Overview

The Multi-Chapter CMP Bootcamp is a participant-led study program built around the CMP International Standards. Rather than passive lectures, participants actively engage by teaching, discussing, and applying CMP domains together—supported by an industry veteran facilitator.

Built for retention: The “learn by teaching” model helps participants move from memorizing content to actually understanding how to apply it.

Accountability + momentum: Weekly structure, assigned prep, and group deadlines keep you progressing toward exam readiness.

Collaborative support: You learn from peers across chapters, plus facilitator guidance to clarify concepts and keep discussions aligned.

Reusable study library: Recordings, slide decks, and quizzes become an on-demand resource you can revisit as you study.

How It Works

Participants take turns presenting assigned CMP domains or chapters.

Each session includes:

- A participant-led presentation
- Group discussion
- Interactive quiz questions, created by presenter as part of presentation assignment

A facilitator supports discussion, clarifies concepts, and ensures alignment with CMP standards.

All sessions are recorded and made available on-demand.

Why Participant-Led Learning?

Research shows that teaching a topic is one of the most effective ways to retain information.

By preparing and presenting content, participants:

- Deepen their understanding of CMP domains
- Identify knowledge gaps earlier
- Build confidence for exam-day scenarios
- Learn from real-world examples shared by peers

Duration:

- 8 weeks of live instruction, April 1 - May 20, 2026
- Classroom Portal opens March 23, 2026.
- 1 on-demand Stakeholder Management module available March 23, 2026
- Final mock exam and review session, May 27, 2026

Preparation:

- All participants must read assigned chapters prior to each session

Presenter Expectations (Participant-Led)

You are not expected to be an expert. Each participant will be assigned a domain (or portion of a domain) to lead—assignments depend on the final number of participants.

On your assigned week, you will:

- Build a short PowerPoint on key takeaways from the reading
- Present live during class
- Submit 5+ quiz questions (with answers)
- Lead discussion and Q&A with facilitator support

Deadlines:

- Submit slides + quiz the Friday (5 days) before your session
- **If you can't present live, submit a recording and PPT 1 week before the class**

CMP Exam Application: What You Need to Know

The CMP exam is administered by the Events Industry Council (EIC).

Important: *Do not apply until you're ready to write—your approval starts a 1-year testing window (and includes rewrite opportunities). Applying too early can limit your flexibility.*

Fees (paid directly to EIC):

- Application fee: \$375 USD (approval valid for 1 year from acceptance)
- Exam fee: \$535 USD
- Reschedule fee: \$75 USD (minimum 90 days between attempts)

Once approved by the EIC you have one year to pay the exam fee and schedule your exam.

CMP Eligibility Requirements (Overview)

Following is an overview of the eligibility requirements for the CMP program. For detailed information about these requirements and acceptable forms of documentation, please download the CMP Handbook and CMP Handbook Addendum.

To be eligible to sit for the CMP exam, your application must include proof of both **EXPERIENCE** and **EDUCATION**.

1) Professional Experience (choose 1)

- 36 months full-time industry experience (within past 5 years; non-consecutive allowed) + resume/CV, or
- 24 months industry experience + hospitality/tourism/event degree (both within past 5 years) + resume/CV, or
- 36 months full-time instructor in industry-related program + proof (course outline/syllabus)

CMP Eligibility Requirements (Overview) - Continued

To be eligible to sit for the CMP exam, your application must include proof of both **EXPERIENCE** and **EDUCATION**.

2) Continuing Education (choose 1)

- 25 clock hours completed within past 5 years (conferences/webinars/classes; aligned to CMP-IS domains), or
- Industry internship: 200+ hours within past 5 years + signed verification letter

Important: *Incomplete/unclear documentation can result in denial—submitted applications can't be edited, and fees are forfeited if denied.*
