Did you know -

A single event, serving over 2,000 attendees at a time, can produce as much waste in an hour as a family of four will produce in one year.



MEETING PROFESSIONALS INTERNATIONAL

The average event attendee will produce between 0.5 lbs and 1.5 lbs of waste each day during the event.





MEETING PROFESSIONALS INTERNATIONAL

The average exhibitor will produce between 8 and 10 pounds of corrugated cardboard alone.





MEETING PROFESSIONALS INTERNATIONAL

In an event in Washington DC, the conference management team collected 315 lbs of aluminum cans.

Recycling those cans will save nearly 13 megawatt hours of electricity which is enough energy to run a television

continuously for 2.5 years.

Some Expected Climate Change Impacts in Sacramento/Tahoe Region:

- More than 100 days/year over 95 degrees in the Sacramento area by 2100.
- Loss of 30-90% of the Sierra snow pack within the next century. (36% loss in the next 50 years best-case scenario).
- Sierra snow supplies 65% of California's developed water.
- Major impact on winter tourism/ski resorts.

Plastic

- In the Northern Pacific Ocean, there is at least 6 times more plastic debris than zooplankton, which forms the base of the aquatic food chain.
- An island of trash twice the size of Texas is floating in the Pacific Ocean somewhere between San Francisco and Hawaii – it's called the Great Pacific Garbage Patch.

Meetings/Events Data:

- During the course of a three day event, the average person attending a meeting will create emissions of more than 1,400 pounds of greenhouse gases — which is the amount a typical driver produces driving his or her car for a month.
- A 3-day conference with 8,100 attendees emits more than 8 million tons of carbon into the air.



- Just offering pitchers of water instead of bottled water for an 1,100 person conference over 3-days can save more than 8,000 bottles from going to landfills and more than \$40,000.
- The typical convention attendee staying at a hotel generates about 20 pounds of trash per day, compared with 4.6 pounds at home.
- Using china instead of plastic disposables to serve 2,200 people snacks, breakfasts, lunches and receptions during a 5-day event prevents 1,900 pounds of plastic from going to landfills.





Rising Green Business Travel

- More than 1/3 of U.S. business travelers "seek out hotels that are environmentally friendly."
- 28 percent say they would be willing to pay 10 percent more to stay in a green lodging facility.
