

## MPI-Oregon Chapter Health & Safety Plan for In-Person Events:

Our members are our highest priority, and we are committed to your health and safety. For the remainder of this year, MPI Oregon Chapter has put together a plan for our safe return to in-person events. Don't worry--we will also have an option for virtual so that everyone has access to the education.

We have done our research and communicated with our industry partners who have successfully hosted live events in the past few months. Not only will we be following all federal, state, local and CDC guidelines, but we have initiated the following strict guidelines for attending in-person events:

To participate in-person, attendees, speakers, venue employees, AV technicians, and all others in our reserved space must either verify their full vaccination or show a negative PCR or Rapid test within 72 hours of said event. We will have a volunteer member checking your vaccination cards or negative tests before entrance into the room. Participants are considered fully vaccinated two weeks (14 days) after they have completed either the second dose in a two-dose series (e.g., Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca) or after a single dose of a one-time dose vaccine (e.g., Johnson & Johnson). Mixed vaccines will also be accepted. In addition to the hard copy vaccination as proof, we will also allow the COVID-19 proof from the secure CLEAR app.
